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Dear Parents and Guardians,

To better manage consistency and accountability regarding your child's course evaluation the following grading policy will be implemented across all schools. This policy does not supersede other specific criteria defined in a child's IEP or 504 plan.

1. Parents will be kept updated via PowerSchool, email or phone about their child's tardy assignments on a regular basis.
2. PowerSchool will be updated on a weekly basis with assignments/assessments.
3. All teachers are available and will respond via email for quick inquiries on your child's progress.
4. Projects will be scored via a rubric provided to each student.
5. Each assignment will be worth a total of 100 percentage points (not including extra credit).
6. A student will lose 10 percentage grading points for each day an assignment is late to a maximum of 50 points penalty.
7. Late assignments will be accepted. However, the maximum percentage score a child can receive, after 5 days of tardiness, is 50% for each assignment.
8. Late assignments will be accepted up to two weeks (10 school days Quarter 2 and 4) prior to the end of the semester. Assignments not submitted will receive a grade of a zero.
9. **No assignments will be accepted after the end date of each quarter (Quarters 1, 2, 3, 4).**

Regular Semester Student Grade : → Quarter 1 Grade = 40%

Quarter 2 Grade = 40%

Final exam Grade = 20%

Honors Semester Student Grade : → Quarter 1 Grade = 40% including 10% honors check in

Quarter 2 Grade = 40% including 15% honors check in

Final exam Grade = 10%

Honors Project = 10%
