### Parking Regulations, Conditions, and Consequences

1. Parking for students is limited to the student parking area in the back of IT and is by permit only (see back for map). One permit is issued per student for the car(s) which are listed above.
2. The permit should be hung on the rear view mirror or displayed on the inside of the windshield at all times. You are registered to this parking permit; you are the only one allowed to use it. If for some reason someone is found using your permit, you will lose your parking privilege.
3. Parking privileges may suspended and/or permanently revoked for each offense for reasons which include, but are not limited to:
  - Speeding or reckless driving.
  - Parking in any area other than the designated student parking section (see back for map). Students driving cars parked in unauthorized locations will be subject to discipline.
  - Parking in a way which interferes with access to an adjacent parking space.
  - Loitering in a car or outside the building.
  - Leaving the building to go to your car without first obtaining permission from the office.
  - Leaving the grounds without permission.
  - Transferring a permit to a car which is not registered with the school.
4. The school is not responsible for damage to motor vehicles by any cause. Any damage to a vehicle or loss of personal property on school grounds is solely the responsibility of the vehicle's owner and/or operator. The school/Board of Education is not responsible for damages to motor vehicles while parked on school grounds for any cause. Such matters should be reported immediately to a security officer or a school administrator.
5. All Connecticut Motor Vehicle Department laws will be enforced on school grounds.
6. Students in poor academic standing (failing 1 or more classes) **must make a concerted effort** to rectify the situation with their teacher. Upon the end of each quarter, all applications will be reviewed and academic records checked. Teachers of the drivers failing courses will be contacted to assure compliance to this rule. A violation may result in a suspension of the permit.
7. The disciplinary records of parking students will be reviewed quarterly. Parking students who do not comply with our school rules and the Board of Education policies will be subject to the forfeiture of their parking permit and ability to drive themselves to school.
